Baseline Audit in the first week of December 2019.



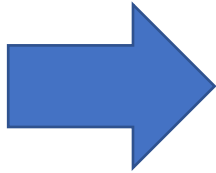
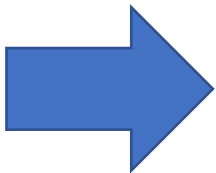

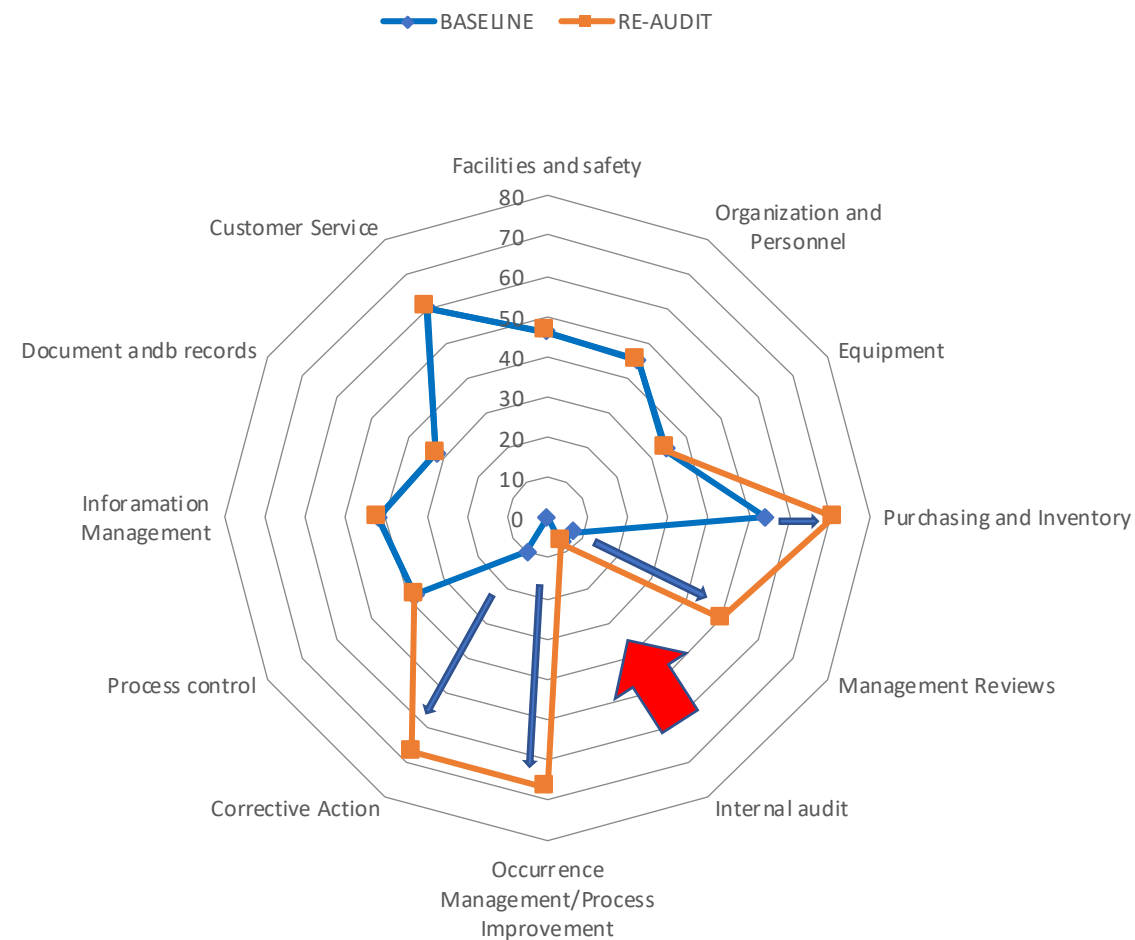
GRAPHICAL INTERPRETATION OF TRANSFORMATION

CHALLENGES

- Delivering duplicate training to achieve 100% delivery
- Inevitable disease outbreaks which slows the Improvement process
- Laboratory staff attending training after their scheduled shifts
- The variance in qualification of the laboratory staff



CONCLUSION

The SLIPTA baseline audit has allowed the respective laboratories to clearly visualize their current status of testing standards, organization and infrastructure through the system gaps and deficiencies being identified.

The impact of SLMTA training has clearly demonstrated immediate measurable improvements through limited resources.
