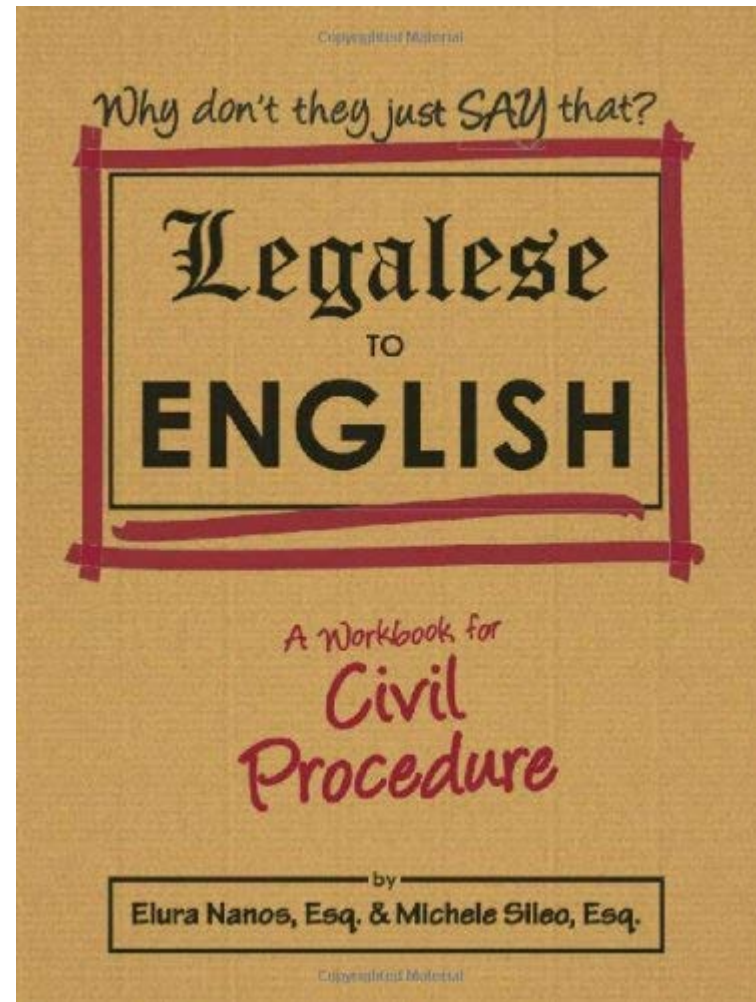

ENSURING A FREE AND OPEN INDO-PACIFIC

- **Purpose was to understand the landscape of activities that the USG and the University of Hawaii provide in the region and to determine whether coordination and synchronization is desirable and possible.**
