JOB PURPOSE: To provide general medical services

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. The physician is expected to use his/her cross-section medical knowledge and skills (including minor surgeries) in the field of Family Medicine;
 2. Provide training to appropriate support staff such as Out-Patient Nurses and Emergency Room Nurses; i.e.
 3. Manage record keeping of patient;


