JOB PURPOSE: To provide medical engineer services

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1.6 Inspect completed work for accuracy and for compliance with pertinent safety regulation.
- 1.7 Develop and conduct in-service education programs on new and existing equipment for biomedical maintenance personnel, physicians, nurses, and technicians to ensure proper use and adherence in safety guidelines.
- 1.8 Establish and implement preventive maintenance programs for biomedical equipment.
- 1.9 Develop system for efficient tracking of all equipment malfunctions, repairs, replacement, and downtime.
- 1.10Prepare budgetary recommendations; maintain variety of relevant records and data and managing various personnel actions including performance appraisals, promotions, and action schedules.
