



January is National Radon Action Month!

Take action this January and get your home tested. Radon is a colorless, odorless and tasteless gas which occurs naturally in Colorado and which can contribute to lung cancer after prolonged exposure in buildings such as homes. Testing is simple and inexpensive: for more information go to www.ColoradoRadon.info. Kits can be ordered at a discount online and can also be found at your local hardware and home improvement stores. If your test indicates high levels in your home and you also income eligible then you could get financial assistance for an in-home radon mitigation system with the [Low Income Radon Mitigation Program](#) or with the [City of Aurora Radon Mitigation Program](#).
