SECRETARY'S CORNER

Update on the Impact Grant benefitting Highlands Elementary and Harvest Youth Club. Cathy Kulas, Helen Mitchell and Michael Hepler stuffed 100 bags for the Harvest Youth Club with Drug Awareness pamphlets, one American Flag and one American Flag pin. Tom Rathz and Cathy Kulas delivered 100 bags of Doritos to Mr. Dixon, the principal of Highlands Elementary, for their Dojo store. 25,635 bottle caps were delivered to Highlands for a total of 48,000. The goal is 100,000. The Green Team, a part of the Community Development Department, gives the school money based on the number of caps. Last year, Highlands was awarded \$500 for 60,000 caps. They hope to receive \$750.00 this year. Bring those bottle caps!!!

The Impact Grant team delivered 550 folders for students, 15 tree stumps for student seating and a plaque noting that the mailboxes were made by Jack Rogers, Elk Lodge 1648 in appreciation for the work teachers do. Four new picnic tables were purchased, to be delivered August 8th.

We have received a lovely thank you note from the principal of Highlands Elementary, Mr. Dixon. He says "Thanks a million for all that you are doing for our Highlands family!!"
