

HAPPI has a limited amount of Moderna vaccine to provide vaccinations to 1st responders and individuals 75 years of age and older. Please request a COVID vaccine appointment online.

Include in this appoint request the following:

- Age of vaccine recipient
- List occupation if qualifying as a 1st responder (bring appropriate documentation).
- Understand that all patients will be screened prior to the appointment and must meet HAPPI's criteria of patients we can safely administer COVID vaccine as well as the State of Alabama current phase of vaccinations.

Do not call our office for an appointment! We are **only accepting online appointment requests**...our staff is unable to respond to these calls! We will call patients as we have vaccine available to accommodate requests. Our initial allotment is 200 doses.
