- The applicant must be a high school senior

On December 3, 2023, Elks members and friends packed 100 bags of non-perishable food items for the underserved students of *Morris Elementary School* and *Buckhorn High School*.

On December 8, 2023, 50 food packs were delivered to each school. While at Buckhorn High School, ER Mike West discovered that their food pantry was empty so it was decided that half of the non-perishable food items that were remaining (which would fill a pickup truck) would be delivered to Buckhorn High School for their food pantry. The other half went to <a href="Harvest Youth Club">Harvest Youth Club</a>.

The Madison County School System declared the Elks Club a Community Partner in their Newsletter.

This concludes the purchases and actions for **Gratitude Grant**. Barbara Stokes will be submitting the final report.

After the Holidays, the furniture, table, and chairs will be delivered to the <u>Huntsville Learning Center</u>. We are just waiting for the chairs to be delivered.

We were able to acquire all the items the Huntsville Learning Center requested because one of the suppliers was willing to work within our budget.

Once all the items are received and delivered, this will conclude the **Beacon Grant**.
