

Secretary's Corner

Dues for fiscal year 2022-2023 will be \$113.00. This increase is from Grand Lodge and their assessment of adequate funding for the Master Liability Insurance Program. Spouse cards and replacement cards are \$5.00 each.



Proposal to amend Section 2.010 of the Laws of the Order:

The above Section now reads (in relevant part) as follows:

Section 2.010. Only the rituals prepared by the Ritualistic Committee of the Grand Lodge and approved by the Grand Lodge shall be used in opening and closing a Lodge meeting, initiation of candidates, installation of Lodge Officers and institution of a new Lodge. Local Lodges may, through their By-laws, adopt alternative rituals approved by the Grand Lodge for the opening and closing of the Lodge.

The proposed amendment would read as follows:

Section 2.010. Only the rituals prepared by the Ritualistic Committee of the Grand Lodge and approved by the Grand Lodge shall be used in opening and closing a Lodge meeting, initiation of candidates, installation of Lodge Officers and institution of a new Lodge. Local Lodges may, through their By-laws, adopt alternative rituals approved by the Grand Lodge for the opening and closing of the Lodge **and initiation of candidates.**

This Resolution is proposed by the Huntsville, AL Lodge No. 1648.

Purpose: The purpose of this amendment is to add the option of the shortened initiation ritual to the Grand Lodge Statues.

VOTING:

This Motion will be read on the Lodge floor during the regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, April 19, 2022 and voted upon immediately thereafter. Upon adoption by two-thirds (2/3rds) of the membership present at the meeting the proposal will be sent to the Grand Lodge Secretary for presentation at the annual convention to be held July 2022 in Atlanta, GA.
