







Accomplishments in September include a new Budget approval (posted on Bulletin Board), member approval for new equipment for the club side and member approval for TOC to rent 10 parking spaces (which will bring in \$550 a month). Membership also approved participating in the new Grand Lodge billing system available to all lodges. This is an automated system

that will be economically and financially beneficial for the Lodge.
