Otto Orf, a twenty-one year professional indoor and outdoor soccer veteran and current resident of Kent, Ohio founded the HandsOnSports Foundation. Otto established himself as one of the most recognizable goalkeepers in the history of pro indoor soccer as an integral part of the Cleveland franchise winning three NPSL championships during his career. Otto has created programs and coached youth for the past 30 years across NE Ohio, nationally and internationally. With his family and network of volunteers he has distributed over 20,000 pair of shoes,



thousands of soccer balls, uniforms and a wide range of other sporting equipment through Project Retread.

What do we do?

Our vision is that every child deserves the opportunity to play any sport they enjoy.

Our mission is to improve a child's quality of life by providing instruction and access to sports. We value

Why are sports important for children?

The HandsOnSports Foundation recognizes that all children need the ability to play sports and improve their health & wellness for life. The value of sports for children is measured by many organizations across the country; see the interesting facts about our children below:

- According to the Let's Move Campaign website, "over the past three decades, childhood obesity rates in America have tripled, and today, nearly one in three children in America are overweight or obese."
- The No. 1 reason that kids drop out of sports is because it's no longer "fun," says the new study from the
 Milken Institute School of Public Health at George Washington University in Washington, D.C. The study,
 published in the Journal of Physical Activity & Health, honed in on the factors that made organized sports
 fun for kids findings that could help combat the rising risks of childhood obesity.
- The study found that there were 81 "fun" factors, which ranged from sportsmanship, to team rituals to "swag" (aka medals or cool jerseys). The top rated factors weren't winning or getting medals, as you would expect but being a good sport, trying hard and positive coaching.

How do we serve children in Northeast Ohio and the world?

Our programs are dedicated to providing recreational and educational opportunities for at-risk youth here at home... and abroad! We meet our mission by facilitating the following programs through your generous support!
