Participants must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Commit to at least 6 months of service with two 2-4 hour scheduled shifts per month (low tides in daylight)
- Contribute to community science data
- Attend scheduled training dates
- Attend at least one team check-in per year
- Be able to move comfortably on the slippery and uneven surface of the rocky intertidal reef

Training topics include:

- Duxbury Reef flora & fauna
- Rocky Intertidal ecology & geology
- Human impacts
- Tidepool stewardship
- California Marine Protected Areas & relevant regulations
- MPA Watch community science
- Docent skills


