TYOU STEM Club meetings will be hosted on Zoom and, therefore, will require internet access (via cable, DSL, mobile, dial-up, broadband, etc.).

FOR THE : PARENTS

The TYOU STEM Club is not associated with any K-12 school or school district, but we will do our best to follow general expectations of an academic program, including professional behavior from all; a zero tolerance policy for bullying; and an expectation that all participants will be respectful of the curriculum, leaders, and technology platforms used during the meetings/events. If an attendee/Club member violates any of the program expectations/policies, they will be asked to immediately leave the meeting/event and may not be permitted to attend future meetings/events, at the discretion of TYOU leadership. TYOU leadership will communicate with you if your student is asked to leave the Club.

Even as a virtual program, the majority of the Club leaders and organizers do hold clearances and have passed the background checks necessary to work with students; special guest speakers and/or presenters are exempt from this requirement.
