# Behavioral Health Certifications for Excellence in Nevada (BHCEN)

**NAC 458.103 Certification required to receive funding from the Division.** A program must be certified by the Division to be eligible for any state or federal funding for alcohol and drug abuse programs administered by the Division pursuant to chapter 458 of NRS for the prevention or treatment of substance-related disorders.

# What Certification Means:

- Eligibility for State & Federal Funding (Including Medicaid Reimbursement)
- Oversight
- Greater Visibility
- Demonstrates Enhanced Provider Credibility

  - Recovery Housing
  - Detoxification Technicians (Individuals only)
    - Approximately 65 certified techs statewide

    - Crisis Stabilization Services

# Recovery Housing



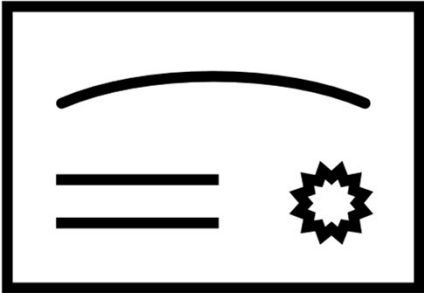

- Recovery housing is a structured, substance-free living environment designed to support individuals in early or ongoing recovery from SUD.
- Programs must;
  - Not manage resident's personal finances.
  - Comply with all local codes and licensing requirements, including maintaining infrastructure and written policies.
  - Report incidents to local authorities and keep a reviewable incident log.
  - Provide safe & equitable access to FDA approved overdose-reversal medication and related education.
  - Teach recovery skills & help residents create relapse-prevention plans.
  - Encourage employment, education, or community volunteering.
  - Promote social engagement & recreational activities.
  - Provide structure and weekly activities.
  - Adhere to SAMHSA's Four Major Dimensions of Recovery

---

# How to get Certified

- Providers are required to complete an application via BHCEN's online portal ALiS.
- CASAT Review
- Reports and Certifications are produced.
- Providers may be issued a 6-month, 12-month, or 24-month certification.
  - If providers are placed on a Corrective Action plan, their certification periods can be as little as 30 days to 90 days.
