# Data Collection & Reviewing Key Indicators

- FR-CARA only: 39,222 doses distributed, and 2,223 individuals trained since the beginning of the grant, September 29, 2022.
  - We're already >100% of our 4-year deliverable (26,740 doses) under the FR-CARA grant (ending Sept 2026).
- FR-CARA + other naloxone grants: 401,297 doses distributed, and 3,670 individuals trained since September 29, 2022.
- Since September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022: 3,064 individuals took the post-naloxone training questionnaire
  - 83.8% feel very confident recognizing the signs of an overdose
  - 90.1% feel very confident understanding of the three steps to administer naloxone
  - 88.8% feel very confident administering naloxone to reverse an overdose
  - 82.2% feel very confident understanding opioids and their effects
- Since September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022: 815 reports of individuals using SNHD's naloxone to reverse an overdose.
  - 86.8% reported 1-2 doses were needed
  - 13.2% reported 3 or more doses were needed
  - 87.4% reported naloxone was used on men
  - 93.1% survived

## Overdose Response with Naloxone Training of Trainers

**6 things to know about OVERDOSE RESPONSE**

- 1 CALL 911**  
Report an **UNCONSCIOUS PERSON**.
- 2 SPRAY NALOXONE EVERY 2 MINUTES**  
Use **MEDICAL HELP ARMIES** or the person's **BREATHES** on their own. The person may not look like they are awake due to non-opioid substances that may also be present.
- 3 PERFORM CPR**  
If you are licensed, **ADMINISTER CPR** between doses of naloxone.
- 4 WAIT FOR AN AMBULANCE**  
It is essential to receive **MEDICAL ATTENTION** after being revived with naloxone as it could wear off before the life-threatening substance does.
- 5 RECOVERY POSITION**  
Keep the person in **RECOVERY POSITION** (roll them on their side) anytime you are not actively helping them with naloxone or administering CPR.
- 6 GOOD SAMARITAN LAW (NRS 453C)**  
The person who calls 911, the person who administers the naloxone and the person being helped are **PROTECTED UNDER THE LAW**.
