Data Collection & Reviewing Key Indicators

- FR-CARA only: 31,948 doses distributed, and 2,184 individuals trained since the beginning of the grant, September 29, 2022.
 - We're already at 100% of our 4-year deliverable (26,740 doses) under the FR-CARA grant (ending Sept 2026).
- FR-CARA & SOR: 321,183 doses distributed, and 3,496 individuals trained since September 29, 2022.
- Since September 30th, 2022: 2,805 individuals took the post-naloxone training questionnaire
 - 83.9% feel very confident recognizing the signs of an overdose
 - 90.4% feel very confident understanding of the three steps to administer naloxone
 - 89.1% feel very confident administering naloxone to reverse an overdose
 - 82.3% feel very confident understanding opioids and their effects
- Since September 30th, 2022: 734 reports of individuals using SNHD's naloxone to reverse an overdose.
 - 86.7% reported 1-2 doses were needed
 - 13.3% reported 3 or more doses were needed
 - 87.3% reported naloxone was used on men
 - 93.4% survived

PROGRAM UPDATES

- Massive increase in distribution from last year, so thank you to all of our partners! Doses distributed: 85,509 (2024), 203,516 and counting (2025)
- Save a Life Day was Sept 25th and was a big success. We distributed over 2000 doses of naloxone and trained over 100 people on overdose response. Thanks to these organizations for participating:

PROGRAM UPDATES

- In 2025 we were able to reclaim 2090 doses of soon to expire naloxone and redistribute them through our Linkage To Action outreach team. This saved an approximate value of \$33,000 worth of naloxone.

PARTNER REMINDERS

- Please do ***not*** redistribute the naloxone to other organizations in bulk. It is intended to equip your staff and to be distributed to individual clients or the general public. If other agencies request naloxone from your organization, please refer them to OD@SNHD.ORG.
- Every person that is distributed naloxone by your staff should receive a brief **training**.

Posters should be posted near naloxone boxes when no staff interaction takes place. Staff should give a brief training to the person they distribute to. The important points that should be mentioned are:

Signs of overdose: - Unresponsive, not breathing, cyanosis, wheezing/gurgling

Call 9-1-1 and wait for ambulance

Spray naloxone in nose every 2 mins: - continue dosing every 2 mins until breathing resumes or medical help arrives

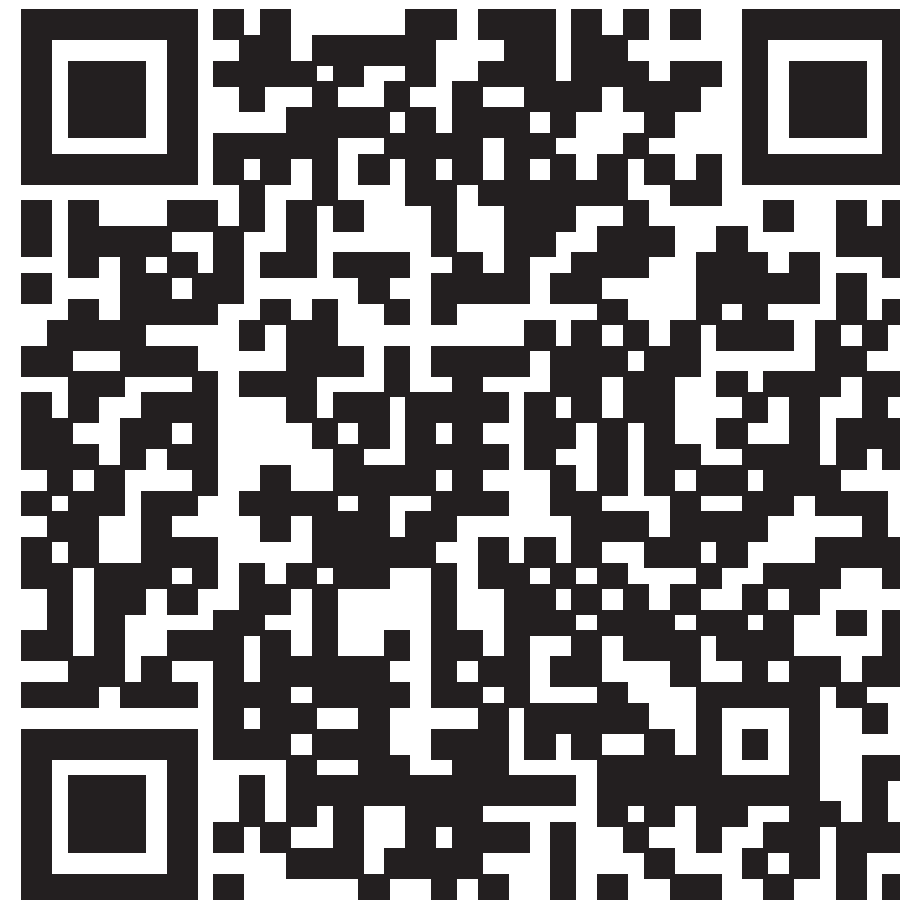
Perform CPR - if certified, perform chest compressions and rescue breaths

Recovery Position - lay the person on their side when not performing CPR or spraying naloxone

Overdose Response with Naloxone Training of Trainers

This class is open to trainers who wish to become educated with current information about the illicit drug supply and the current best practices for reversing overdoses. At the end of this training, you will be equipped with the knowledge and tools to train others in overdose response, understand opioids and their effects, and educate others on common myths regarding drug overdose and fentanyl. Prerequisite work is required and will be sent by email. This no-cost training is completely grant funded.

Training includes:

- Understanding the effects of opioids
- Understanding the community drug supply
- How to recognize opioid overdose
- How to respond to and reverse an opioid overdose
- Tips and tricks for training others on this content
- Training materials

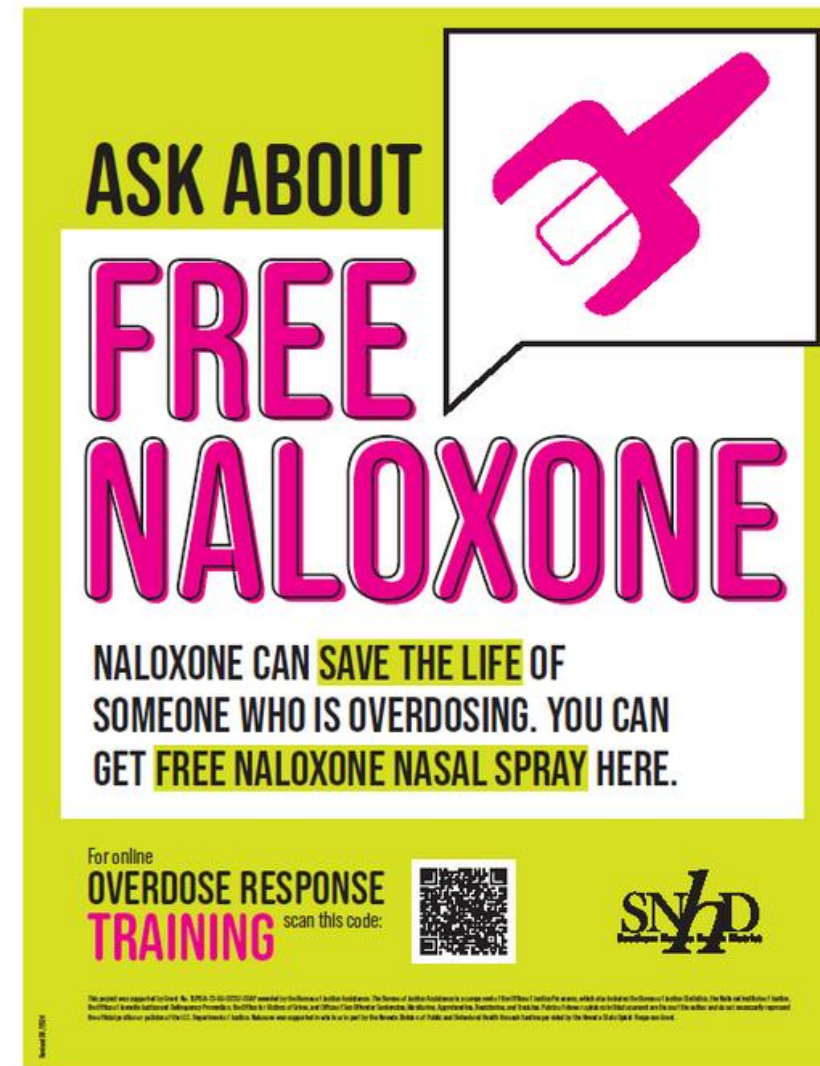

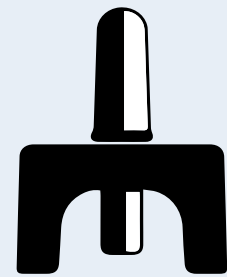
