Data Collection & Reviewing Key Indicators

- FR-CARA only: 27,057 doses distributed, and 2,158 individuals trained since the beginning of the grant, September 29, 2022.
 - We're already at 100% of our 4-year deliverable (26,740 doses) under the FR-CARA grant (ending Sept 2026).
- FR-CARA & SOR: 243,363 doses distributed, and 3,391 individuals trained since September 29, 2022. \bullet
- Since September 30th, 2022: 2,523 individuals took the post-naloxone training questionnaire \bullet
 - 85.0% feel very confident recognizing the signs of an overdose
 - 91.0% feel very confident understanding of the three steps to administer naloxone
 - 89.7% feel very confident administering naloxone to reverse an overdose
 - 83.3% feel very confident understanding opioids and their effects
- Since September 30th, 2022: 621 reports of individuals using SNHD's naloxone to reverse an overdose.
 - 85.3% reported 1-2 doses were needed
 - 14.7% reported 3 or more doses were needed
 - 86.5% reported naloxone was used on men
 - 93.7% survived



SAVE A LIFE DAY!

The Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) will be participating in a national initiative—Save A Life Day— on September 25, 2025. This important event is focused on expanding low-barrier access to naloxone for the general public in an effort to prevent opioid overdose deaths and is in partnership with SOAR of West Virginia (learn more about the national initiative here: https://soarwv.org/save-a-life-day-2025/)

Program Updates

- Q3 ordering is now open Get your order in before the deadline of July 21st. Check your email or send a message to OD@snhd.org to get the order form.
- How to order naloxone We ask that you request by the number of doses you want. Each little white box of Narcan has 2 doses. Each shipping box we give you has a total 24 doses, or 12 little white boxes of Narcan inside. If you want enough to hand out to 100 people, you would want to order 200 doses (each person should get 2 doses). Then, round up into multiples of 24 doses. So if you want 200 doses to hand out, (200 ÷ 24 = 8.333, so round up to 9 boxes of 24 doses which is 9x24 = 216 doses) you would order 216 doses.
- Still getting expired doses Please check your supplies each quarter and return soon to expire doses BEFORE they expire.
- **Shout out** to these agencies for returning their soon to expire doses: Army National Guard, LV Metro Police Dept., City of LV Dept. Of Public Safety, Boyd Gaming, Caesar's Entertainment, Resorts World, North LV Police Dept., District Court Marshals, Coral Academy of Science, NV State Police Dept of Parole and Probation,
