

AGMT Program Beta Tests in Cleveland

January, 2019 - The Architectural Glass and Metal Technician Certification program (AGMT) just completed its latest, and final beta test. The exam was given to local glaziers in Cleveland, OH.


The testing provided the team with unique participant perspectives and another opportunity to witness the glazing tasks in action. With each of these events, the exam content and structure become more solidified.

A total of six glaziers participated in the Cleveland beta, bringing the total count of beta participants to more than thirty nation-wide.

One local participant, Jason Liskai, said the exam is “exactly what I do every day.” The goal of the exam is to simulate tasks that experienced glaziers do regularly. It is only through this process that a glazier’s competency and abilities can be measured.

The performance results are currently being analyzed, giving the AGMT team an accurate indication of future testing results and helping land on a final cut score.

This marks the end of official beta testing for AGMT and brings the program one step closer to rollout. Live testing is set to begin in March of 2019.
