Does your student need a job? Does your student have Federal Work Study (FWS) award listed as part of their financial aid package?

If so, we have an amazing job where they are paid to work at local nonprofits here in Tampa. They receive their FWS award while gaining great work experience and making a positive impact in the community.

Currently, students may be placed at one of our four Tampa non-profit partners: Metropolitan Ministries, Junior Achievement Biztown & Finance Park, Joshua House, USF Feed-a-Bull, and the YMCA Reads literacy program. Positions will be posted on Careers@USF and are open on a rolling basis until filled. Depending on your student's availability and the non-profit's needs, students typically work between 10-20 hours per week. Two partners are located on campus. However, if placed at a site off campus, students must find their own transportation. Students are currently paid from their FWS award at a rate of \$10 an hour.

Please note, student employees:

- May not work during scheduled class times and may not be excused from class in order to work on campus.
- May not work more than a total of 20 hours per week while classes are in session (including the week of finals).
