



## Emory Brain Health Center Integrated Memory Care Clinic

For some families living with dementia, visiting a clinic location to receive excellent dementia care or geriatric care isn't always easy. Leaving home, commuting, parking, and visiting an unfamiliar location can be a burden in its own right.

Emory **Integrated Memory Care** is a nationally-recognized primary care clinic for people living with dementia. The clinic features an interdisciplinary team and is led by nurse practitioners. This innovative, one-of-a-kind model is launching a new program that will deliver care to patients living in a senior living community. Our first location is the Orchard at Brookhaven.

For a monthly fee, the new Integrated Memory Care in Community program will deliver both traditional healthcare and non-traditional care services. A highlight of this program includes 1:1 weekly engagement activities with a Dementia Care Assistant, who has targeted dementia training, and will work closely with the nurse practitioner and occupational therapist to implement engagement activities.

The Community program will have the same goals and philosophy families have come to expect from the Integrated Memory Care Clinic. We will continue to partner with families in decision-making.

The Integrated Memory Care in Community program will provide:

- Primary care by a nurse practitioner who specializes in dementia care
  - Care coordination for timely preventative care
- Support groups, educational groups, and caregiver support for family caregivers
- After-hours number for evenings and weekends for family members of established patients
  - Evaluation and individualized treatment plans by an occupational therapist
- Weekly tailored activities by a dementia care assistant with dementia care expertise
  - Pharmacist medication reviews
- Support for transitions of care to hospice or skilled nursing care as applicable
