The Camp Lions of Illinois program was created in 1957 by the Lions of Illinois Clubs to be a gateway for summer camp fun for blind and deaf children. Camp Lions offers, free of charge summer camp with experiences provided for sighted & hearing youth. The word "no" was not in the thought process for Camp Lions. Just because a child did not have normal vision or hearing did not mean they were incapable of enjoying swimming, crafts, archery, team sports, nature walks, baseball, football, or even canoeing. Camp Lions allowed children, who were considered different to many in the everyday world, to belong to their own summer society. A gathering of new and old friends all peers with similar lives.

These same feelings about Camp Lions are stronger than ever today. Camp Lions is still a safe haven for deaf/hard of hearing and/or blind/partially sighted kids to spread their wings and their potentials. Campers still rush in at check-in and forget they left their parents standing. They are too busy, free to be themselves, talking with their hands, feeling that familiar grip or sound of a voice that identifies a friend or Counselor. The room is electric with dancing hands and sparkling smiles. And that is just the first few minutes of Camp Lions.

It is not awkward, no one will make you feel uneasy. There are ample hearing campers that sign and Counselors who will interpret for you. Talk to the children from your service area. Learn how really "ordinary", and yet exceptional, these campers are. Feel the gratitude they have for the Lions for giving them Camp Lions. Sit and enjoy a camp meal of hot dogs, burgers, beans, chips, all the eats one expects at summer camp, and the meal is FREE to all attendees. See all that the grounds have to offer for a fun, challenging, and safe program. Listen to campers stories of their lives at home, their family, and their dreams. They love to share - You are a Lion, a trusted friend.

Please, don't miss this afternoon in the park. Meeting the campers allows you to know & understand who you help serve through your support of Camp Lions. And yes, bring a friend or loved one, even children. I guarantee, each of you will have a wonderful visit not soon forgotten.

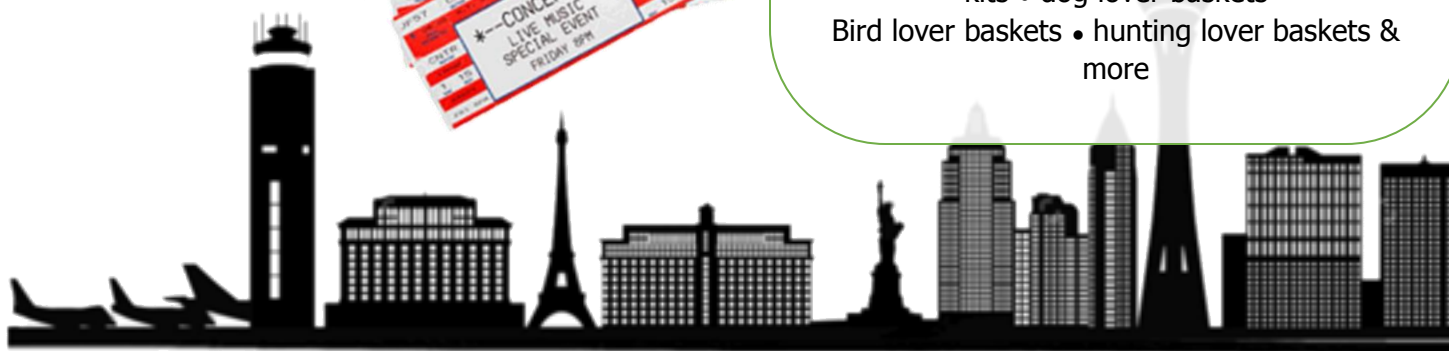

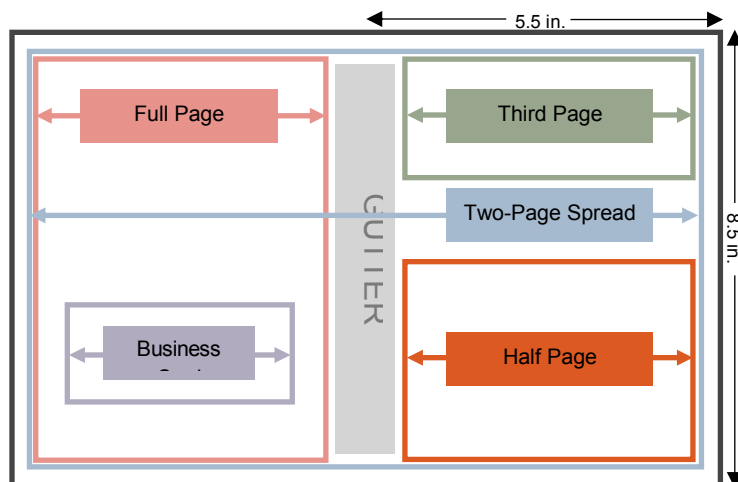
