





The National School-Based Health Alliance, California School-Based Health Alliance, and Regional Asthma Management & Prevention are pleased to share a funding opportunity for school-based health centers. Eight school-based health centers (SBHCs) across the country will be selected to receive \$8,000 to conduct activities aimed at reducing environmental asthma triggers, as part of a National School-Based Health Center Asthma Demonstration Project Collaborative. Participating SBHCs will receive technical assistance from content experts, opportunities for peer learning with other SBHCs, and tools and resources to better support students with asthma, over a two-year period. Applications are due August 17<sup>th</sup>, but we highly encourage you to complete and submit the very short application before heading out for summer break.
