

The West Virginia Drug Intervention Institute (WVDII) is excited to announce, through the generous funding support of a private donor and in collaboration with the West Virginia Primary Care Association (WVPCA), all West Virginia Community Health Centers (CHC) are eligible to receive two ONEbox™ emergency opioid overdose kits per CHC location. Health Centers may use the kits in their facilities or share with community partners.



The ONEbox™ is an on-demand, one-of-a-kind, technology-enabled opioid overdose rescue response kit intended to contain two doses of naloxone, an opioid reversal medication along with personal protective equipment. The box also contains instantaneous video instructions (in both English and Spanish) that are activated when ONEbox™ is opened. Using a

bystander intervention model, this video talks the responder through the overdose emergency and administration of naloxone. A training mode is also available for use during a non-emergency.

The ONEbox™ kit is designed to promote safety by assuring an individual can provide lifesaving support with the help of on-demand training. The ONEbox™ uses visual and multilingual voice instructions to guide users through the entire process, from the moment it's determined help is needed, through the naloxone administration, all the way through rescue breathing and contacting emergency officials. The ONEbox™ can be utilized during an emergent situation or as a training tool, with a long form video individual and group naloxone administration trainings.

Distribution of the ONEbox™ kits will be shipped to one CHC location, with your staff responsible for distributing them to additional sites or community partners. If your health center has already purchased ONEbox™ kits, we unfortunately won't be able to offer a refund, however, you are still eligible to receive two ONEbox™ kits per location and if you choose, can distribute them to a community partner if your location already has them on site. The installation of these kits is the responsibility of the receiving CHC.

While the ONEbox™ kits do not come with naloxone, The West Virginia Drug Intervention Institute is committed to ensuring these tools are ready for use by providing naloxone to health centers who request them.

1. Complete lines 1 – 8 with your information (or the information of the main contact).
 - a. 'COMPANY/ORGANIZATION' should be the FQHC – not a specific site.
2. Provide the **TOTAL** number of ONEbox™ kits for all interested locations (*EX: 8 sites x 2 kits each = 16 total ONEbox™ kits*)
3. If you would like to receive Naloxone in addition to the ONEbox™ kits, select YES.
4. Under Shipping & Delivery Options select **SHIP**.
5. Delivery Contact can be the same as above or someone different – that's up to you.
6. **SKIP THE DISCOUNT CODE SECTION**. (This is a general form used for multiple groups. These ONEbox™ kits will be provided to you at **NO COST**.)
7. Under the 'Special Instructions' comment box, include any of the following you wish to receive:
 - a. Indicate if you would like to receive ONEbox™ training, which will be scheduled by DII via Zoom.
 - b. Indicate if you wish to receive Naloxone in addition to your ONEbox™ kits.
 - c. Any FQHC-specific instructions for shipping.
8. Review and Agree to the Terms of Purchase
9. Provide electronic Signature.
10. Click verification box (You are NOT a robot)
11. Click **SUBMIT FORM**

Kits should begin arriving approximately two weeks after being ordered. It should also be known that the value of each kit is \$200 without the added naloxone.
