STEPS TO APPLY

- 1. Go to the <u>VSU Application</u> and click "Apply Now".
- 2. Create an account with <u>GAFutures</u>. Once you've created an account, you'll fill out your profile information and submit it to **GAFutures**. (Please note: students not from Georgia can create one as well.)
- 3. Once your account has been created, go back to the <u>VSU Application</u> and click on "Apply Now".
