Seven days a week, remind someone special about God's love, the gift that truly keeps on giving.




What you need: \

- Large plastic pill box with a compartment for each day
- Construction paper
- Craft glue
- Black permanent marker
- Heart stickers
- Scissors
- Bible
- Pencil
- 7 small treats (fish-shaped crackers, small candies,

trail mix, etc.)



- Glue paper onto the container. Write "God's Love" in permanent marker. Decorate with heart stickers.
- 2. Cut seven slips of paper. On each slip, write out one Bible verse about God's love. (Examples include Psalm 63:3; Psalm 100:5; John 3:16; John 15:12; Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:9.)
- 3. Fill each compartment with a different treat. Then place a folded slip atop each treat.
- 4. Give away the present. Tell the recipient to open the correct day for a week and then refill the treats and verses and "regift" God's love to someone else.
