### Richmond Urgent and Primary Care Centre (UPCC)

If you can't see your primary care provider (family doctor or nurse practitioner), you can go to the Richmond UPCC for non-life-threatening illnesses or injuries such as:

- Sprains and strains
- Cuts, wounds or skin conditions
- Fever
- Infections (chest, ear & urinary tract, etc.)
- Asthma
- New or worsening pain
- Less serious child illness & injury
- Worsening chronic disease

Note: medical imaging and lab services not available on-site.

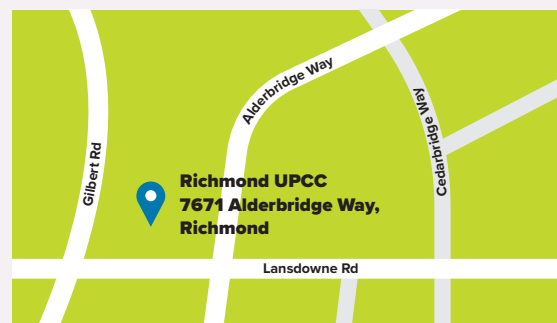
#### Clinic hours:
