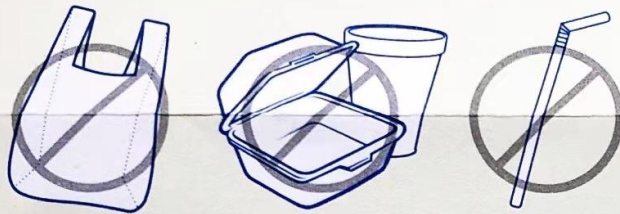


Let's choose to reuse

Richmond's single-use plastic ban starts March 27, 2022

The Single-Use Plastic and Other Items Bylaw No. 10000 was adopted to help reduce unnecessary waste and plastic pollution, and the new ban affects all businesses operating in Richmond.



Starting March 27, 2022, Bylaw 10000 bans:

- foam food service ware
- plastic checkout bags (including biodegradable/compostable plastic)
- plastic straws (including biodegradable/compostable plastic)

What residents can do:

- **Bring a bag:** bring reusable checkout bags when you shop.
- **Carry a cup:** bring your own cup when you're out for coffee, tea, bubble tea or other beverages.
- **Skip the straw:** don't use a straw when you're out at restaurants, or bring your own reusable straw if needed.
