There's still time to get your Child Tax Credit

*Apply even if you have no income or low income and have not filed a 2021 tax return.

**File a simplified tax return before mid-November to receive these benefits!

Key Facts

- *Parents can receive \$3,000 or \$3,600 per child ages 0-17 depending on the child's age.
- *All eligible families can receive the full credit if they make less than \$150,000 for a married couple or \$112,500 for a single parent in 2021.
- *Non-taxable and it does not affect other federal benefits
- *Anyone who has a child with a social security number can receive the credit amount even if they do not have a social security number themselves.
