

New Additions

Because of you, 2019 was an amazing year for outdoor ministry at Camp Grier! Many thanks to you for making this possible! We celebrated the construction of two new buildings:

- the Alexander Boat House & Swim Dock and
- the Magnolia Riding Arena

The Alexander Boat House

New Salem Presbyterian Church in Stony Point, NC contributed funds for a new addition to Lake Refuge. Construction began on the Alexander Boat House in January. We are now able to store canoes and other lake equipment out of the elements. A large swim dock is also the perfect place for campers and staff to

enjoy an afternoon swim! We are so very grateful to New Salem for their generosity and vision for outdoor ministry as central to the life of the church.

The Magnolia Riding Arena

The Magnolia Riding Arena is a tremendous addition to our equestrian program! Construction began on the arena in March and was completed in May. The new arena allows our campers and staff to ride comfortably in inclement weather and also provides some much needed shade in the summer.
