OUR WORK IN KAZAKHSTAN

St. Giles has worked in Southern Kazakhstan since 2001 through our mission partner, Interlink Resources. We have shared the love of Jesus for many years through serving orphans and poor and disabled children/adults, teaching English, business education and consulting, and providing medical assistance and supplies. St. Giles' main focus now is working to strengthen and encourage the Kazakh Church, which is experiencing many young people coming to faith in Jesus. We have come alongside 12 pastors and their families in Taraz and Almaty to encourage and support them by providing seminary education, discipleship training, educational and medical assistance to their families, and Christian Fellowship.

OUR WORK IN EGYPT

Since 2014 St. Giles has had a sister church in Cairo, Egypt, the El Talbiya Evangelical Church, which ministers in a poor and heavily Muslim section of the city. Their Pastors, Abdalmissah and Theodore, have become good friends, hosting us when we have visited there, and visiting us here. We have had three medical mission trips there, and helped them install an elevator in their six (!) story building. This new partnership is already bearing good fruit for the Kingdom.
