Historical background

The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu was founded by bishop Angelo Negri, a Comboni Missionary.

In 1936, he was inspired to start a Congregation for the African Sisters, fulfilling the desire expressed by his predecessor Monsignor Antonio Vignato, Apostolic Prefect of Equatorial Nile.

The Congregation began in Gulu in 1936. Ten girls who felt the vocation to serve as sisters were placed under the care of Rev. Sr. Angioletta Dognini, a Comboni Missionary Sister who became a confoundress of the Congregation.
