



Partner with Child Advocacy Service to Advocate for Children in Need

1. **Organize a prayer team:** Start a prayer ministry to pray for the needs of children in foster care.
2. **Host an Informational Session:** Invite family, friends, community, and a church congregation to learn about becoming a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer and advocate for the best interests of children in court.
3. **Host a CASA Training:** Provide a meeting space and refreshments for CASA trainings.
4. **Adopt-a-CASA:** CASA volunteer advocates work tirelessly across 10 parishes in our communities. A civic group, business organization, and/or a church can "adopt" the local CASA program in your community and host a recognition event to support volunteers who are advocating for the best interest of children.
5. **Outreach:** By placing a volunteer sign in your business window or yard, you become a voice for a child in need.
6. **National Blue Sunday:** The last Sunday in April is National Blue Sunday, a day when churches across the nation pray for abused and neglected children and their abusers.
7. **Board of Directors:** Consider serving on our board.
