


# The Little Red Schoolhouse on JDSF

The Little Red Schoolhouse (visible along highway 20) was built by the Caspar Lumber Company to serve the children whose families worked and lived near the lumber company logging camps.

The school opened in 1915 and at that time there were approximately ten families and 22 children that were served by the schoolhouse.

The schoolhouse was located at three different camps. Originally, it was at Camp One, in 1929 it was moved to Camp 19, and in 1939 it was moved to Camp 20 where it remains today.



The schoolhouse was built as one piece and then cut into three sections to be moved. The sections were pulled on skids to the railroad where they were then loaded onto flat cars and moved to the next camp.
