Situation Summary:	The Glass Fire burned actively throughout the night due to low humidity and above average temperatures at the higher elevations. Overnight, crews experienced active fire behavior that included slope-driven runs, flanking, and single tree torching. Downed trees and other dry fuels continue to threaten the fire line.
