Bruce J. Walck, AIA, MRAIC, is President of Powers Brown Architecture, an international professional services firm practicing architecture, interior design, programming and urban design. **Walck**, has been a principal of the firm since 2008, and has worked in the firm's Houston headquarters, as well as established the firm's offices in St. John's, Newfoundland in 2015 and Toronto in 2017.

As president, Walck is responsible for the overall operations and efficiencies of the firm, plus developing strategic initiatives to expand its multifamily portfolio, and grow the manufacturing, medical and industrial project work in new and existing markets in North America. He works closely with clients from programming through construction administration in corporate office, retail, mixed-use, multifamily, government and industrial design.

Walck joined Powers Brown in 2003 as a project manager and by 2008 the founding partners named him the firm's first new principal.
