BOSTON, MA - J&M Brown Company, the Jamaica Plain, MA-based NECA member, is underway with the core and shell electrical construction of One Congress, the stunning 600 foot, 43-story office tower in Government Center. The centerpiece building of the Bulfinch Crossing development, One Congress is designed by Pelli Clarke Pelli Architects. The building will feature a unique curved, folded glass design, and when it opens in 2022 the 1 million square-foot structure will be Boston's tallest building in over three decades, since One Financial Center opened in 1984. Congress will be the future headquarters facility for its anchor tenant, State Street Corporation. The building is being constructed to meet LEED Gold Certification standards. J&M Brown is on a project team headed by general contractor John Moriarty & Associates.
