## COPING WITH THE CHALLENGES OF LIFE - FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF A 9/11 WIDOW

Margie is the immediate past International President of Women's League. She recently served as a vice president of Mercaz and a board member of JTS, Ziegler, USCJ and American Friends of Neve Hanna.

Margie Miller grew up in Valley Stream, Long Island. She received her Bachelor of Arts from Hofstra University with a double major in Sociology and Psychology.

Margie and her first husband Charlie Sivin z'l, became active at the Baldwin Jewish Center in Baldwin, NY. She ultimately became the first woman Congregation President in her non egalitarian synagogue.

Margie's second husband Joel Miller z'l was killed at the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001. For seven years after the events on 9/11, she was a family bereavement specialist for South Nassau Communities Hospital's "WTC Family Center". Margie coordinated family outreach and programming for the bereaved and first responder's families. She travels throughout the country speaking about the effects of 9/11 on family members.
