COMPUTER LAB

GAME ROOM

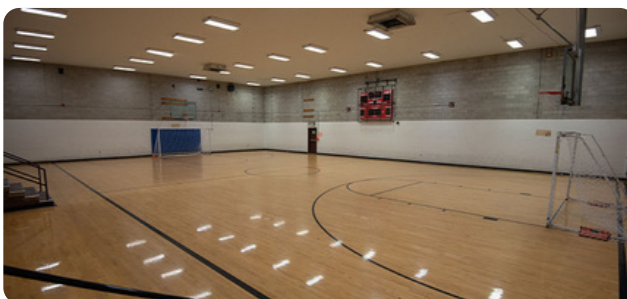
Adults and kids have access to a pool table, bumper pool, foosball tables, air hockey tables, ping pong, a chess and checkers table, and a large screen TV with access to Xbox Kinect active video games.

GYMNASIUM

In the gym, boys and girls choose from supervised activities like indoor soccer, basketball, kickball and dodge-ball. Adult recreation is also offered in the gym for both team sports and pick-up games. Basketball or tennis shoes are required to play in the gym. No street shoes are allowed.

WEIGHT ROOM
