This year Advent is coming just around the corner, starting December 1st. I am

excited for Advent! It is the one piece of the church year I have yet to truly celebrate with you all here. Last year, Mari had just been born and Kelly and I were trading off sleeping shifts and getting through happy but long days with our newborn. I am tremendously grateful for the gift of that time, given by you all, and by clergy colleagues Jeff Japinga and Denise Dunbar-Perkins.

This year, as we get ready to dig into Advent, I have been struck by the ways that the words of the prophet Isaiah, about preparing the way of the Lord, and how they seem connected with the ways we fill our Decembers. Through scripture and preaching, we'll look at some of those activities of December busy-ness – the shopping, the decorating, the celebrating, even the going to church – that so often make us feel crazed and hectic this time of year. And, to look at those texts from Isaiah that share a quieter purpose to this time of year.

We are also looking ahead, planning-wise, for Christmas Eve. Last year I loved the elements of worship – the gathering of the nativity, with all who wanted or were able to wear a crown or a shepherd's cloak or the ears of a stable animal; and I loved the candlelight ending of the service and the music of the choir. In conversation with the worship committee, we've set one Christmas Eve service this year, at 7:00pm, to incorporate both of these elements into one service, a new tradition of Christmas in joy and reverence. 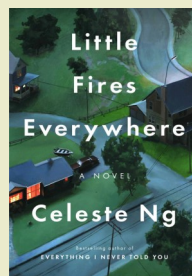
