Advent Wreath Making - November 29, 2020

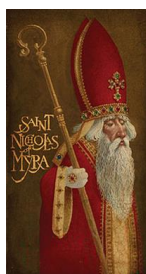

More About the Advent Wreath:

The four candles of the Advent wreath marks the passage of time through the four weeks leading up to Christmas. Three of the candles are purple, a liturgical color signifying prayer, expectation, and sacrifice. The third candle is pink and symbolizes joy. The wreath as a whole is meant to remind us of God's infinite love and the promise of everlasting life which comes to us through Jesus Christ.
