
THE HORSE'S BRAIN – a users manual

This is an amazing opportunity to learn about how your horse's brain is structured and how they think by world leading neurosurgeon Dr Steve Peters.

Dr. Stephen Peters, Psy.D., ABN, Diplomate in Neuropsychology and currently the Director of Intermountain Health Care's Center for Brain Health. For the past 7 years he has also served as the Director of American Fork Memory Clinic. Dr. Peters is a board certified Neuropsychologist and spent 15 years in a large Neurology practice in

Connecticut before founding the Memory Clinic and Clinic for Brain Health at Utah Valley Hospital. He did his Internship at Danbury Hospital and residency and two year Post Doctoral Fellowship at Hartford Hospital in the Departments of Neurorehabilitation, Neurology and Neurosurgery..

He is a neuroscientist specializing in brain functioning. As a horse brain researcher, he has given numerous presentations in the U.S. and Canada, performed many horse brain dissections, and is the co-author with Martin Black of Evidence-Based Horsemanship. He also collaborates with BHPS director, Maddy Butcher, on HorseHead: Brain Science to Improve Your Horsemanship.

Dr. Peters recently collaborated with Mark Rashid and Jim Masterson (Masterson Method) on a two day seminar which is currently being made into a dvd.

His presentation will focus on relevant equine brain science including the importance of neurochemistry especially the dopamine system in reward and learning. Peters' will discuss the latest research and its applicability to your interaction with and understanding of horses. He will perform a horse brain dissection to illustrate points from previous lecture. Gloves will be provided to all participants as they are

encouraged to make this a "hands on" activity.

The second day of the clinic will be practical demonstrations both in groundwork and ridden of how the horse learns and thinks. Participants will have the opportunity to work with a horse and feel how they process information.

Dr Steve Peters will give an in depth lecture on the structure and functions of the equine brain and how it relates to training and learning. There will also be a dissection of an equine brain and you will get an opportunity to examine (if you wish) the major structures of this amazing organ.

Sunday 15th August 2021- 9.00am – 4.00pm Lectures and Practical demonstration through Ridden and Groundwork exercises.

This builds on what will have been covered the previous day with live demos in real time of the learning and processing the horse uses in day to day training. Dr Peters will be narrating throughout the demos and translating what is actually happening in the equine brain. Participants can if they wish try some practical groundwork to experience the learning process themselves.
