Committed to “be diligent stewards of God’s creation and support eco-justice for all people of our one planet,” as affirmed in our Just Peace Declaration of 2010, the members of the Presbyterian—United Church of Christ further resolve to live out that commitment in all aspects of our life together:

- 1. In worship that gives joyful thanks for the great gift of creation and humbly acknowledges our dependence on God’s grace to faithfully respond to that gift;*
- 2. In education for people across the lifespan that illuminates the complex interactions in the web of life and the human actions that threaten to tear that web;*
- 3. In responsible management of our physical and financial resources with constant care for conservation and sustainability;*
- 4. In public advocacy to ensure that God’s abundance is shared equitably by all people and preserved for future generations.*
- 5. Acknowledging that “the earth is the Lord’s, and all that is in it” (Psalm 24:1), we pray that we may care for the earth as God cares for us*
