Additional Instructions

All events, rehearsals, and ceremonies are <u>mandatory</u>, except for Grad Bash and Prom JR/SR Dance, which are optional activities.

Seniors will wear caps and gowns to the **Senior Honors Ceremony**, **Baccalaureate Mass, and Graduation Ceremony**. At these three events, **proper dress**, IDENTIFIED BELOW, is required to be worn under the cap and gown. PLEASE NOTE: <u>If a senior is late for a ceremony or is improperly dressed</u>, he/she will not be permitted to participate in the <u>ceremony</u>.

Men: MUST wear a <u>WHITE</u> dress shirt with a collar, top button fastened, with a **TIE**, dark dress slacks, DARK DRESS SHOES (leather uppers with smooth soles; no sneakers or sandals), and dark dress socks in keeping with the guidelines from the Student Handbook, p. 20. Males are to be cleanly shaven and hair is to be worn according to school guidelines. No khaki pants, top-siders, deck shoes, athletic shoes, canvas shoes, boots may be worn. Only one earring stud may be worn in each ear, with no visible tattoos, or body piercings. No extreme hair colors or styles are permitted. The cap and gown may not be altered in any way. Only honor cords, stoles, or medallions issued by the school are permitted to be worn with the gown. The mortarboard tassel should hang on the right side of the cap until instructed to change it during the graduation ceremony.

Women: MUST wear a solid color, non-printed <u>WHITE</u> or <u>PASTEL</u> dress that is of a length shorter than the academic gown and in keeping with the guidelines from the Student Handbook, p. 20, and <u>WHITE</u>, <u>TAN</u>, <u>GOLD</u>, or <u>NUDE</u> DRESS SHOES or DRESS SANDALS (no flipflops, backless shoes, or sneakers). No slacks may be worn. No corsages or pins may be worn on the academic gown. Only two earrings (maximum) may be worn in each ear, with no visible tattoos or body piercings. No extreme hair colors or styles are permitted. The cap and gown may not be altered in any way. Only honor cords, stoles, or medallions issued by the school are permitted to be worn with the gown. No flowers will be carried during the processions. The mortarboard tassel should hang on the right side of the cap until instructed to change it during the graduation ceremony.

It is imperative to follow these dress guidelines. Once again, a senior who is late for a ceremony or is dressed improperly will not be allowed to participate in that ceremony. If a student is absent for the Senior Honors Ceremony and/or Baccalaureate Mass, he or she will not be able to participate in the Graduation Ceremony.

Caps and gowns will be distributed to seniors on **Wednesday**, **May 15**, **2024**. All fees and accounts must be settled with the Director of Finance before a student can receive his/her cap and gown, AND before he/she is permitted to sit for exams. Seniors will wear their caps and gowns for the first time at the Senior Honors Ceremony on **Friday**, **May 17**, **2024**.

Saint Michael the Archangel Catholic Church has seating for 1,400 and tickets will not be issued for the Baccalaureate Mass on **Tuesday**, **May 21**, **2024**. Doors will open at 5:45 PM. Seating in the designated areas of the church will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Please remember that this is a celebration of the Eucharist, so **families are reminded to dress appropriately for this semi-formal**, **religious ceremony**, and to refrain from taking pictures when it would interfere with Mass.

The Eleanor Dempsey Performing Arts Center has a limited number of seats, so each family will receive a ten (10) ticket allotment for the Graduation Ceremony to be held on **Thursday**, **May 23, 2024.** Admission is by TICKET ONLY, and there will be NO ADMISSION WITHOUT A TICKET. Some families may not need all their tickets, while some may want more. *It will be up to the families of seniors to make arrangements among themselves for additional tickets that may be needed.*

Lobby doors will open for the Graduation Ceremony at 6:15 PM. EDPAC seating will be on a first-come, first-served basis in the designated areas. Families who require accessible seating for a person with a disability must contact the Graduation Coordinator, Mrs. Jane Schuster, by email (jane.schuster@bmchs.com) to reserve such seating, with one additional companion seat reserved next to the person with a disability. These two (2) tickets are included as part of the senior's ticket allotment. Other family members and guests will be seated as they enter the Performing Arts Center. Any senior who would like to invite a special diocesan guest must contact Mrs. Schuster by email (jane.schuster@bmchs.com) in advance to reserve seating in our special diocesan guest seating section.
