Exactly what is BNAC?

BNAC stands for “Bishops and Auxiliary Council” It is an assembly of: the Executive Board, national auxiliary/ministry leaders, national committee chairpersons and national support staff.

What is the purpose of BNAC?

BNAC serves multiple purposes. In brief, BNAC serves as major collaboration effort to insure that the various components that make up our national convention work together as a team enabling our national convention to add even greater value to all of our districts, temples and the greater local and global community. It is a recognition, celebration and proper application of all of the various gifts within the body of Christ.

Who may attend a BNAC meeting?

BNAC primarily consist of all of our: Executive Board, national officers, department and ministry leaders, committee chairpersons and many of our national support staff; however, there will be an “open-session” where any member of the church may come and hear our national plans and have an opportunity to share their ideas, comments and suggestions with our national leadership.

Do national church leaders have to attend BNAC?

During our 2018 national convention, everyone appointed to a national office agreed to meet in April 2019. Critical decisions will be made during our BNAC meeting. All decisions will be binding on all national leaders whether present or not. In addition, to insure proper execution of these decisions, in the absence of national leaders, it may require assigning specific duties and responsibilities to those individuals who were present. Please inform the BNAC team if you do not plan to attend.

Will national leaders receive any assistance to attend BNAC?

Reduction in room rates depends greatly on the number of individuals who plan on staying at the host hotel. That being said, we are diligently working to secure the lowest rates available.
