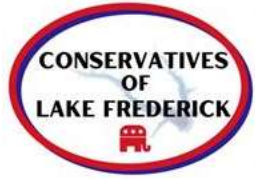
- You are the front line folks staged outside of the polling location

- Be Polite

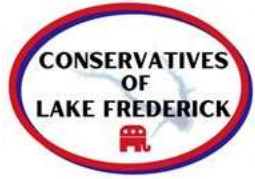




# Rules



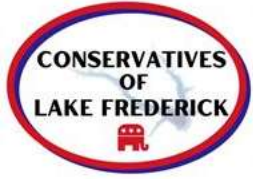
- All greeters, signs, and literature must be 40 feet from the polling entrance.
- If you need to go inside to vote or use the restroom you will need to remove or cover up anything that promotes a candidate.

- Yes, you may wear patriotic clothes and hats (e.g. Trump hats)

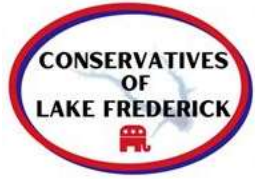




# What Will be Furnished

- Bring A Smile 😊

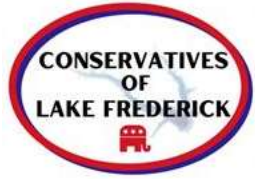

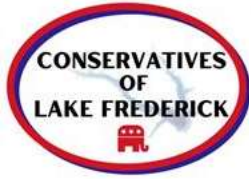

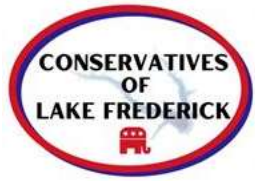
