

JCS KINDERGARTEN Screening

What is Kindergarten Screening?

Kindergarten screening is one important tool we use to help determine if your child is ready for PreK or Kindergarten. At Jenison Christian School, we see each child individually as a child of God and we want to find the best fit for your child. The screening process is designed for 4 year old preschool students to help make a recommendation based on readiness tests and discussions with our teachers. This screening time is also a great opportunity to learn more about the programming available at JCS and to have any questions you may have answered.

Is it a requirement for PreKindergarten or Kindergarten?

We highly recommend that your child is screened. If you already feel your child is kindergarten ready or that he/she would benefit from prekindergarten, we would like to screen your child to affirm your decision. The screening also helps our staff better get to know your child. We keep the screening on file in our office for our records and for your child's teacher to view.

When is Kindergarten Screening?

Screening week at Jenison Christian is Friday, January 29 and Saturday, January 30. The appointments last approximately 15 minutes with cleaning in between. We will screen on Friday, January 29 from 9:00AM-3:00PM or Saturday, January 30 from 9:30AM-12:30PM . There will be 2-4 screeners available at each appointment time.

How do I sign up?
