### *Community Profile*

*Miramar is a community of 31 square miles with approximately 140,000 residents. The median age of the population is 36 and of those 25 or older 90% have a high school diploma and 30% have a bachelor's degree. 40% of the population is foreign-born and 47% speak another language at home. There are about 43,000 housing units, 70% of which are owned and have a median value of approximately \$264,000. The median household income is approximately \$66,560.*

*On the business side, there are approximately 2,700 businesses with 40,000+ employees. Prominent business sectors include aviation, communications, healthcare and manufacturing. There are planned office and industrial commerce parks and community-level retail centers. As of 2021, there is 3.5 million square feet of office space; 3.5 million square feet of retail space; and 9.6 million square feet of industrial space.*
