2019-2020 Project Report (Year Three of Four)

Projects conducted with both the Tate Topa Tribal School and Warwick Public School included:

- *Steve Dunn Writing Workshop* (8 educators, grades 7-8)
- *Roads to Success* college/career curriculum implementation (329 students, grades 6-8)
- *RUReadyND* implementation (329 students, grades 6-8)
- *Virtual Job Shadow* access (170 students and their educators, grades 7-8+)
- Business presentations in the schools (375 students, grades 5-8, and 37 businesses)
- College tours, business tours, the college/career keynote speaker, and the *Gearing Up for Middle School* student/family program were postponed due to COVID-19.

Projects conducted with Tate Topa Tribal School included:

- Marzano Research *High Reliability Teacher* program
 - HRT Level 1 Certification (12 educators total)
 - HRT Level 2 Certification (3 educators in Grant Year Three; 7 educators total))

Projects conducted with Warwick Public School included:

- NESC-facilitated weekly instructional coaching (English Language Arts; 10 educators)
