April 10 **Palm Sunday** – Welcome Jesus in Palm Procession

April 11 **Holy Monday** — Holy Eucharist

April 12 **Holy Tuesday** — Holy Eucharist and Anointing of Hands for Ministry

April 13 **Taizé Tenebrae** — Service of Light and Shadows

“Tenebrae” comes from the word for “shadows.” After each reading on Jesus’ suffering and death a portion of candles is extinguished. The growing darkness signifies the apparent triumph of evil. The Christ Candle remains lit to remind us that even as all else fades away the light of Christ shines.

April 14 **Maundy Thursday** — Holy Eucharist with foot washing and stripping of the altar featuring the Bell Choir

This service commemorates the Last Supper when Jesus took, blessed, broke, and gave the bread and wine, washed his disciples’ feet, and gave them a new commandment to love one another. “Maundy” comes from the word for “commandment.”

Prayer Vigil Overnight Maundy Thursday to Good Friday

“Jesus said to his disciples ‘Sit here while I go over there and pray.... I am deeply grieved, even to death; remain here, and stay awake with me.’” (Matthew 26:36ff)
Pray and keep watch with the reserved sacraments at the altar of repose in the Chapel. The Prayer Vigil is coordinated by the Daughters of the King (DoK).

April 15 Good Friday | Offerings to support ministry in the Holy Land

Friday Noon Stations of the Cross

Each station recalls a stop on Jesus’ journey from trial to tomb from the point of view of Mary. The Stations of the Cross is coordinated by DoK.

Solemn Prayers, Passion Gospel, and Veneration of the Cross, 7PM

Participants pound a nail into the cross to represent the part played in Jesus’ death and the leaving of sin at Jesus’ cross. Special music will be presented by the choir.

April 16 Holy Saturday Morning Service, 9AM

The service provides a mid-morning break for those preparing for Easter Day.

April 16 Easter Eve (also called the Great Vigil) — This year we will join the congregations of Deanery 6 at Christ Episcopal Church in Ontario at 8PM. There will be no service this evening at St. Mark’s.
