### **A Safe and Healthy In-Person Worship Service: Oct 31**

The St. Mark's Readiness Taskforce together with the Worship Committee are pleased to announce that on **Saturday, October 31 at 9:00 AM**, our first outdoor gathering since the Coronavirus pandemic will take place.

This **communion service** will follow strict guidelines compliant with diocesan, city, county, and state recommendations. Everyone will be required to wear a face mask that covers both your nose and mouth. Due to limited seating, **reservations will be required**. We are accepting reservations until 12 noon on Thursday, Oct 29 or once we reach capacity. Please indicate whether you will need handicap parking.

Readers and presenters, please bring your own readings - there will be no lectern or podium. If you are interested in helping with our cleaning crew, please let Carol Morgan know.

### **Before you come on campus...**

Please self-screen before leaving for church. Check for: fever > 100.4 F or chills; cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; fatigue; muscle or body aches; headache; new loss of taste or smell; sore throat; congestion or runny nose; nausea or vomiting; or diarrhea. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, please stay home.

You will be asked to check-in and fill out a health screening form. Your temperature will be taken using a no-contact thermometer. Hand sanitizer will be available for your use (operated with a foot pedal). You will be asked to wear a face mask covering your mouth and nose. You will be given a pair of disposable gloves to wear during the service.

Ushers will direct you where to sit and when to be dismissed. Children must remain in the care of their household unit and not interact with other household units.

And the basics: Maintain physical distance (6 feet apart). Chairs will be positioned accordingly. No handshakes. No hugs. No bumping elbows. Prayers said out loud should be said quietly. No singing.

Please monitor your personal ability to be outside with the current air quality conditions.

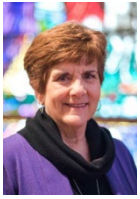

# Lives shaped by The Beatitudes

Today's Gospel recalls Jesus' sermon on the mount, commonly referred to as The Beatitudes. In his usual manner, Jesus surprised his followers by uttering godly, countercultural truth. In essence, his teaching that day laid the foundation for what it means to live a Christian life.

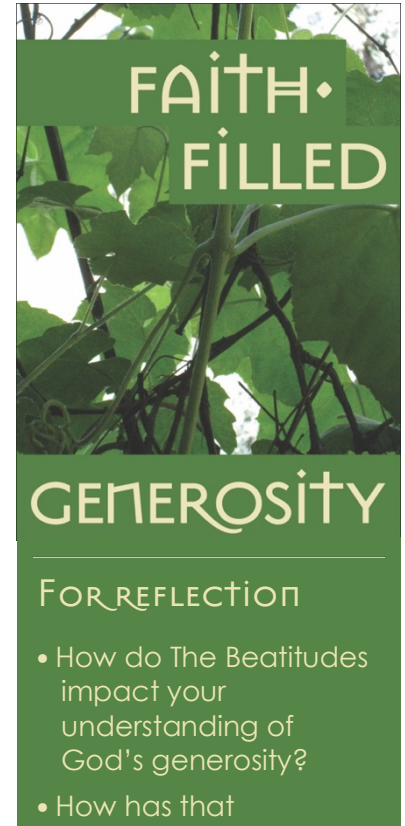
What does it mean to be merciful, pure in heart, meek, poor in spirit, mournful, to be a peacemaker, to hunger and thirst for righteousness and be willing to be persecuted for it? The Beatitudes are a guide that, when studied, reveal layers of meaning for us as believers. They challenge many of our basic human desires and behaviors. Of ultimate importance, they clearly reveal what God seeks to bless.

Aren't we fortunate that our God is forgiving and full of grace as we strive to be transformed by these teachings? Our journey of formation requires change and opening our eyes to see God in action all around us. Included in this change is seeing God's endless blessings poured out upon us and developing a posture of gratitude in return.

Being thankful changes us for the better. Being thankful changes our perspective on life and can profoundly impact our understanding of God's generosity. Being thankful can shape us to be stewards of all God has entrusted to us. Being thankful softens our fears. Being thankful turns fear of scarcity into joyful gratitude for God's abundance.

We remember the saints who have gone before us on this All Saints Day. Some were revered as saints of old. Some were modern day saints. Some were simple folks like you and me. One distinguishing characteristic of saints is that we can see how they embodied and lived Jesus' teachings, these very Beatitudes. They generously gave of their lives so much so that we remember them today. We are confident they were blessed by God for their faithfulness. May we be thankful for their witness and see in them lives shaped by The Beatitudes and be willing to do the same.
